- We use low cost energy like bio-gas plant to cook our food, Bio-digester to prepare bio-pesticide, unique flow forms to dynamise water and apply innovative rain water harvesting techniques.
- You can understand the role of bulls, calves, cows, dogs, chickens, rabbits, ducks, earthworms and birds in our organic cycle.
- Watch the milking of cows at 5 pm to rediscover the source of milk.
